Day 1:

Guided Walking Tour of Baroque Rome

Meals: Breakfast, Dinner

Arrive at the Rome airport! You will be met by your English-speaking tour conductor who will remain with your group during their stay and who will also provide common phrases of the Italian languages. Transfer to the city center, where you will enjoy an afternoon walking tour of Baroque Rome: discover the Trevi Fountain, Spanish Steps with its theatrical staircase of the Trinity of Mounts, Navona Square, the Pantheon (outside). These sites and fountains will help you understand the unique charm of the "eternal city." Dinner at local restaurant. Overnight in Rome.

Guided Tour of the Vatican

Meals: Breakfast

Breakfast at the hotel. Meet your private guide for the tour of Vatican: the Vatican museum, which houses the Sistine Chapel and most important collections of art in the world, and the Basilica of St. Peter, the largest in the world. They contain work of the most important Renaissance and Baroque artists. Afternoon free at leisure. Overnight in Rome.

Day 4:

Guided Tour of Ancient Rome

Pizza Making Class

Meals: Breakfast

Breakfast at the hotel. Meet your private guide for a walking tour of Ancient Rome. This archaeological area is one of the richest and most fascinating in all the world: see the Capitol, religious and political center of the city, the Roman forums, the Arch of Constantine and the Colosseum. They remain as visible testimony of the city's ancient past. In the afternoon, partake in a pizza making class! The class will start with the most important part: making the dough. Next up is a lesson in rolling out the pizza and creating your finished creation, complete with different delicious toppings. Then you will be tasting the pizza delights you have created. Overnight in Rome.

Day 5:

Transfer to Sorrento

Visit Pompeii Site

Meals: Breakfast

Breakfast at the hotel. Board your private coach and transfer to the Sorrento area. On the way, stop in Pompeii for a visit of the world-famous archeological site: in the year 79 A.D., the town was destroyed by an extremely violent eruption of Vesuvius. The roads, monuments, homes and gardens (including all the inhabitants) were buried and "sealed" at the time of the eruption, laying underneath five or six meters of earth for centuries. They are near perfectly preserved and have provided valuable insights into what life was really like at the time of the eruption. Overnight in Sorrento area.

Day 6:

Full-Day Visit of Amalfi Coast

Meals: Breakfast

Breakfast at the hotel. Embark on a full day excursion to the Amalfi Coast. The Amalfi Coast is one of the most spectacular coastlines in Europe, if not the world. Not only will you enjoy breathtaking views, you will stop at the Belvedere in Positano and you will also have the chance to visit the pretty town of Amalfi, with its famous cathedral. Visit the charming village of Ravello with Villa Rufolo. Picturesque villages dot the countryside overlooking the sea—this lovely image will stay with you long after you've returned home. Overnight in Sorrento area.

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Day 7:

Transfer to Florence

Visit Siena

Meals: Breakfast

Breakfast at the hotel. Board your private coach and transfer to Florence. On the way you will stop in Siena, a mysterious city situated on the summit of three hills. Its narrow, winding streets are part of its charm. The Cathedral (outside visit), with its splendid façade in multi-coloured marble; the Piazza del Campo, heart of the city, with a unique shell-like shape; the Gaia Fountain; the Public Palace (outside visit), a masterpiece of gothic civil architecture; and the remarkable Mangia Tower.

Arrive and meet your guide for a walking tour of Florence (3 hours): headsets will be provided for all tours. Visit Seignior Square, the exquisite Loggia dei Lanzi and its sculptures, the magnificent Cathedral of Santa Maria del Fiore, whose façade is decorated with marble, the bell tower, and the Baptistery, with its famous Paradise gate. This is followed by Ponte Vecchio, the covered bridge, which is renowned for its many jewelry shops. The tour will visit the outside only of these buildings. Check in to your hotel in Florence. Overnight in Florence.

Day 8:

Return

Meals: Breakfast

Have one last Italian breakfast at your hotel. Transfer privately from the hotel to your departure airport for your return flight. It is important to arrive at least three hours before your international flight is scheduled to depart.
