Day 1:

a.m. Depart from your camp for Boston, MA.

a.m. 80 min. Boston Duck Tour, subject to schedule.

Enjoy a narrated tour of Boston landmarks given inside an authentic renovated World War II amphibious landing vehicle, which splashes into the Charles River for a breathtaking waterside view of the city!

p.m. Walk over to adjacent Quincy Market/Faneuil Hall.

Time for sightseeing, shopping, and a meal voucher for lunch.

Located in the heart of Boston and bordered by the financial district, the waterfront, the North End, Government Center and Haymarket. Sprawling on 6.5 acres and attracts millions of visitors annually. It's the Nation's Premier urban Marketplace. There are approx. 49 shops, 44 pushcarts, 13 full service restaurants, and 35 food stalls.

p.m. Entrance to the New England Aquarium located at Central Wharf with IMAX.

The new open-air pavilion features a 60-foot long 68,000-gallon pool. The new Boston Harborwalk wraps around the Center so that visitors can view the seals from the Harborwalk. Enjoy a documentary IMAX movie at the aquarium.

p.m. Depart for your camp.
