p.m. Depart for Grand Ole Opry located at 2804 Opryland Dr, Nashville, TN 37214.
Approx. 15 minutes of driving time depending upon the traffic.

p.m. Arrive at Grand Ole Opry House.

p.m. Arrive. Opry Country Classics show at the Grand Ole Opry.

a.m. Entrance to the Country Music Hall of Fame and Museum.
Honors singers, songwriters, and industry executives who have contributed to country music. Displayed are costumes, films, instruments and records, Grand Ole Opry memorabilia and personal items of country music's legends and superstars. The Museum is open daily from 9:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. Summer Hours: 8 a.m. Fridays and Saturdays from Memorial Day to Labor Day. Allow 2 hours to visit the Museum.

p.m. Walk 3 blocks to the Assembly Food Hall for lunch on your own. With 30 food stalls, it is in the Fifth + Broadway complex in the heart of downtown Nashville, close to iconic landmarks, event venues, and cultural attractions such as the Ryman Auditorium, the Country Music Hall of Fame, the National Museum of African American Music, and Bridgestone Arena. Fifth + Broadway offers visitors of all ages an outstanding collection of shopping, dining, culture, and entertainment found nowhere else in the city.

p.m. Walk across to the Ryman Auditorium located at 116 5th Ave N, Nashville, TN 37219.
Approx. 10 – 15 minutes of walking distance.

Approx. 30 minutes of driving time depending upon the traffic.
- a.m. **Arrive at the Grand Ole Opry House.**
- p.m. **Arrive. Guided Backstage Tour of the Grand Ole Opry House.**
The tour offers visitors a behind-the-scenes look at the celebrated 4,400-seat venue and country music's most famous show, including themed dressing rooms, the artists' entrance, and more.
- p.m. **Depart for Nashville Zoo at Grassmere located at 3777 Nolensville Pk, Nashville, TN 37211.**
- Note:** **After dropping off at the unloading zone the bus can park at the upper parking lot close to Nolensville Pike. There will be parking attendants to help with parking on the day.**
- p.m. **Arrive. Admission to the Nashville Zoo at Grassmere.**
Features wildlife indigenous to Tennessee and animals from around the world, including Bengal tigers and cougars. A 300-pound anaconda lives in "The Unseen New World" exhibit along with amphibians, fish and other reptiles grouped by geographic region.

- p.m. **Depart for Schermerhorn Symphony Center located at 1 Symphony Pl, Nashville, TN 37201.**
Approx. 15 mins of driving time depending upon traffic.
