Seine River Cruise

Meals: Breakfast, Dinner

Enjoy breakfast at your hotel before heading to the Louvre, a world-class museum institution. Plan which pieces you would like to see in advance, as the museum can become impossible to navigate if you don't have a game plan! Afterwards you will visit the art-nouveau-architecture district of Paris, the 8th and 9th arrondissement district. Admire some of its most beautiful buildings like Gare St Lazare, Opera house Palais Garnier and world-famous department store Galleries Lafayette. Transfer to the Montmartre, where famous painters like Van Gogh, Renoir, Toulouse l' Autrec lived and found their artistic inspiration. Gather for dinner at a local restaurant before taking to the River Seine for a picturesque evening cruise.

Day 4

Attend Local Mass

Admission to the Palace of Versailles

Meals: Breakfast, Dinner

After breakfast, attend a Mass at a local church (this can be an English or French speaking Mass). After Mass, discover the Notre Dame area to see the renovations of the Cathedral Notre Dame and visit Ile de la Cité.

After lunch on your own, transfer via metro to the Palace of Versailles with an audio tour as your guide. Admire the glory and splendor of Versailles when you enter the gilded world of King Louis XIV. You'll visit the opulent Grand Apartments, the stunning chandelier-lit Hall of Mirrors and the Queen's apartments. Once your visit to Versailles is complete, enjoy dinner at a local restaurant in Paris.

Day 5

Time at Leisure

Overnight Transfer to Strasbourg

Meals: Breakfast, Dinner

Enjoy breakfast at your hotel before time at leisure until your overnight transfer to Munich. Your tour leader will provide suggestions for today's activities.

After breakfast, depart for Dachau Concentration Camp. Built in 1933, Dachau was the first Nazi concentration camp. The main hall houses photographs and models of the camps and gives you insight into the horrendous acts against humanity that were often performed at the camp. After this sobering visit, continue to Munich, the capital of Bavaria. Enjoy a half day guided city tour to see the Odeonplatz, the Old Town Residence, The Palace of Nyphenburg and the Marienplatz before gathering for a group dinner and overnight Munich.

Day 7

Admission to Neuschwanstein

Visit Wies Church

Meals: Breakfast, Dinner

After breakfast transfer to Neuschwanstein. Drive through the scenic German countryside on your way to the legendary extravagance of the German castle Neuschwanstein! Find out why many believe Neuschwanstein inspired Disney's storybook castles and get ready to feel like you're living a real-life fairy tale. Hidden in the seclusion of the mountains, German King Ludwig II built two of his dream castles: Neuschwanstein and Linderhof. Both testify to the vision of Bavaria's fairytale King.

Continue to Wies Church. Thomas Zimmermann designed this church in the midst of meadows, forests and peatbogs. A sober exterior conceals the magnificent Rococo Baroque interior. Transfer back to Munich for your farewell dinner at the Hofbrau House (subject to availability). Here you can see German folklore with lederhosen, dirndl dresses, Bavarian hats and yodel! Overnight in Munich.

Day 8

Admission to Deutsches Museum

Afternoon at Leisure

Meals: Breakfast, Dinner

After breakfast you will visit the Deutsches Museum, the world's largest museum of science and technology! It was founded over 100 years ago. You will see locomotives, airplanes, cars and other technological marvels. Your afternoon will include time at leisure for souvenir shopping. Some suggestions for activities include visiting the BMW Museum, Old or New Pinakothek, and the Olympic Park. Subject to availability, enjoy a farewell dinner and show in the Hofbrau House (subject to availability). Here you can see German folklore with lederhosen, dirndl dresses, Bavarian hats and yodel! Return to your hotel for the evening and make sure to pack your belongings for tomorrow's departure.
