### **Day 1:**

**a.m.** Depart from your school for **Montreal**

**p.m.** **Explore Old Port of Montreal**  
Stroll down the gorgeous Saint Paul Street, walk through the Old Port, visit the Place d'Armes and admire the beautiful Notre Dame Basilica as the students take in the epitome of French culture in Montreal. Nearby, you can also find Montreal's own Chinatown

**p.m. Dinner at a local restaurant**

**Option:** For an additional cost, we can arrange dinner at Chez Suzette, where you can enjoy a traditional French meal.

**p.m. Depart for your hotel.**

**Day 2:**

**a.m. Flow into the common area for deluxe continental breakfast at the hotel**

**a.m. Depart for a local school for competition/adjudications for Marching Band, concert Band, wind ensemble, choir, percussion, jazz band and/or color guard.**

**p.m. Walk to the Eaton Center of Montreal** which is a shopping mall that is a part of the Underground City, Montreal

**p.m. Lunch on your own** in any of the restaurants located at the Eaton Center.  
The underground city is a conglomeration of commercial building linked by tunnels. These underground passages allow you to avoid weather extremes while you shop and stroll. This underground mall is the perfect place to witness the hustle and bustle of everyday Montreal life and grab a quick bite. Enjoy lunch, sightseeing, and shopping on your own

**p.m. Entrance to Notre-Dame Basilica of Montréal.**  
**Performance for your band (40 performers),** subject to availability  
**Tour of the Basilica**

A masterpiece of Gothic Revival architecture, Notre-Dame Basilica was built between 1824 and 1829. The magnificent interior in wood and the boldly modern design of the Notre-Dame-du-Sacré-Coeur Chapel, captivate hundreds of thousands of visitors each year. Paintings, sculptures and stained-glass windows illustrate biblical passages as well as 350 years of parish history.

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**Option: For an additional cost:**

Spend 30 mins. with organist Pierre Grandmaison to discuss his trade, training, daily routine, creative process and, of course, his work tool: the organ. He has worked as an organist at Notre-Dame since 1973. An accomplished artist, he has given concerts both in Europe and the US. He has, among other things, played at Notre-Dame de Paris three times. Also, as a composer, he wrote and played a solemn mass for Montreal's 350th anniversary in 1992 and, more recently in 2005, an oratorio for the 100th anniversary of the St-Joseph Oratory.

**p.m. Dinner at a local restaurant**

**p.m. Return to your hotel**

**Day 3:**

**a.m. Flow into the common area for deluxe continental breakfast at the hotel**

**a.m. Depart for The Montreal Tower**

**a.m. Guided tour of Olympic Stadium**, subject to availability

Discover the tradition dating back decades and showing the evolution of Canadian Olympic competition. The duration of the guided tour is usually 30 minutes. Upon returning from the guided tour, the group will be able to visit the exhibition "Since 1976" on their own, which requires generally 20 or 30 additional minutes. Expected duration of full activity is 1 hour.

**a.m. Depart for Quebec**

**Note: You will stop at Traditional Huron Site**

**1:00 p.m. Enjoy a guided tour of Traditional Huron Site in Wendake**

Learn about Native American culture as students explore this authentically reconstructed Huron Village

**p.m. Lunch onsite at Village Restaurant**

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**Option:** Depart directly for Quebec City from Montreal. Do not stop at Traditional Huron Site, and instead arrive at the Museum of Civilization in Quebec City with lunch on your own.

**p.m.** Depart for **Quebec City**

**p.m.** **Explore Old Quebec with dinner on own**

Marvel at this historic and iconic district of Quebec City. Old Quebec has much to offer, including historic buildings, cobble stone streets, and a long, rich history. Make sure to stop at Place Royale, the cradle of French Canadian civilization. Admire the New France early architecture—its gabled roofs and chimneys will transport you back to the 15<sup>th</sup> century.

**p.m.** **Depart for Ghost Tour**, subject to availability

**p.m.** **Old Quebec Ghost Tour**

**p.m.** The Ghost Tour **ends**. Depart for local hotel
