Day 1:

a.m./p.m. Check in at the airport two-three hours prior to departure

a.m./p.m. Depart from your local airport for San Diego, CA

a.m./p.m. Arrive in San Diego

San Diego is a city on the Pacific coast of California known for its beaches, parks and warm

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climate. Immense Balboa Park is the site of the renowned San Diego Zoo, as well as numerous art galleries, artist studios, museums and gardens. A deep harbor is home to a large active naval fleet, with the USS Midway, an aircraft-carrier-turned-museum, open to the public.

We will hire a local Bus charter which will be waiting for you at the airport.

p.m. Dinner at local restaurant such as Casa Guadalajara

p.m. Night time tour of Gaslamp Quarter

The Gaslamp Quarter is a lively downtown neighborhood, known for its nightlife. Clubs, dive bars and cocktail lounges draw a young crowd, while the Spreckels and Balboa theaters have diverse programs of music, comedy and drama. There's a mix of chain and independent restaurants in the area, with many global options. Horton Plaza Park has grassy lawns, ice cream and coffee vendors, and an interactive fountain.

a.m. Embark on a guided tour of San Diego – 1 guide per bus

a.m. Arrive for lunch at Liberty Station Public Market

Liberty Public Market is a 7-day a week Public Market and event venue offering the best of what the region has to offer. Showcasing a rustic environment with prepared foods, produce, fish, desserts and pastries, pastas, arts and crafts, a test kitchen, pop up dinners, and educational driven events.

p.m. Clinics for band and choir at the University of California San Diego (UCSD)

Music at USD is home to a talented, energetic and committed community of faculty and student musicians. Students approach foundational coursework (music history, theory,

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composition and performance studies) in relation to politics, art, literature, religion and cultural studies. The holistic curriculum prepares students for careers as professional musicians.

p.m. Outdoor band and choir performances at the Arts District Liberty Station

This is the place where artists can showcase their craft in either art, performance, design, fashion, culinary deliciousness, and even beer. It is a hub for growth, innovation, and inspiration promoting connection, creativity and community.

p.m. Arrive at the Seaport Village. Time for shopping and sightseeing on own

A 14-acre waterfront shopping, dining and entertainment complex recreating a harbor side setting of a century ago. Includes 54 one-of-a-kind shops, 13 casual dining eateries, 4 fine dining waterfront restaurants, and located in close proximity to local hotels. Opened in 1980.

p.m. Ocean Kayaking Ecological Adventure – La Jolla Shores

This fully guided kayak tour takes you through the Ecological Reserve and along the La Jolla

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Sea Caves—some of San Diego’s most famous attractions. The La Jolla Ecological Reserve and Underwater Park is a marine protected area that’s a famous destination for snorkelers, divers, and kayakers to respectfully explore. The Reserve is home to some friends—leopard sharks, Garibaldi (California’s state marine fish!), lush kelp beds, sea lions, and even the occasional pod of dolphins!

Built for the 1915-16 Exposition, along with the adjacent Lily Pond and Lagoon, the historic building is one of the largest lath structures in the world.

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p.m. Admission to World Famous San Diego Zoo with guided bus tour.

The San Diego Zoo is a zoo in Balboa Park, San Diego, California, housing over 12,000 animals of more than 650 species and subspecies on 100 acres of Balboa Park leased from the City of San Diego.

Enjoy a ride Skyfari Aerial Tram on own!

Take an airborne shortcut over the treetops to the other end of the Zoo and enjoy spectacular views of the Zoo and surrounding Balboa Park. Subject to availability
